Congratulations on your enrollment in the Kauai Team Challenge program! We look forward to getting to know you! In preparing for the course, here are some things to consider:

Attire

There is a good possibility that you could get dirty during the day. Please wear clothing and shoes that you do not mind scuffing up a bit.

Clothing should be loose, comfortable, casual, durable, and include a rain jacket or poncho if you don't like to get wet.

Shoes should be low heeled and comfortable such as hiking or running shoes.

Jewelry, watches, and cell phones are not welcomed on the course.

Glasses and contact wearers should take any precautions you would normally take when participating in outdoor activities to protect your eyes and your eyewear.

Tobacco products, gum and candy are not allowed on the ropes course or during activities for safety reasons.

Participants

High Ropes participants aged 9 and above need to be in normal physical condition and able to climb a tree/ladder. If you have any conditions limiting your physical or mental ability please inform us so that we may assist you and better meet your needs. Please remember that the activities are designed to for varying levels of abilities and our philosophy is to "Challenge by Choice".

Low Ropes participants can be any age with any level of physical and mental abilities. Please inform us if there are any special considerations for your group.

Be sure to bring a large bottle of water. Participants may be able to re-fill their bottles throughout the day.

Directions to Waipa

To find us, you will pass Hanalei town Northbound, and cross the cement bridge just after Hanalei Elementary School.

Approximately ½ mile mauka side, you will see a purple sign “Farmers Market on Tuesdays”. . These are the first buildings you will see on the left after the bridge. Turn left and park on the left hand side in the large open parking area. This is our meeting point.

The high ropes course is located across the highway. Follow the dirt road along the beach for 100 yds. back toward Hanalei town. The course is past the two houses on the right hand side.

Conduct

As an experientially-based program, we expect all participants to accept the full value contract: play safe, play fair, play hard and have fun. We also have a no tolerance policy for violence, drugs and alcohol, sexual harassment, and/or discrimination. Participants who are sent home for disciplinary reasons will not be eligible for any refunds.

Cancellation Policy

Kauai Team Challenge Inc. requires 48 hr notification on cancellations. Participants failing to meet the 48 hr notification will be charged full price.

Communication
